**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE DEEPAK MAHESHWARI**

**Order**

None came present on behalf of the petitioner-wife. Rejoinder has also not been filed on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel Dr. Shailendra Kala appearing on behalf of the respondent-husband submits that under the interim order passed on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2016, proceedings in Case No. 488/2015 have been stayed and the progress of the divorce petitioner is being delayed. He submits that to expedite the matter, order may

kindly be passed to transfer the Divorce Petition No. 488/2015 from the Family Court, Jodhpur to the Family Court, Jaipur with a direction to conclude the proceedings within a give time-frame.

On perusal of the transfer petition, it appears that this is the only case pending between the parties. However, in the interest of justice, it appears essential that the proceedings may take place as expeditiously as possible. Keeping this fact into view and the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent-husband, this transfer petition is allowed and the Divorce Petition No. 488/2015 titled as "Dr. Akhil Govil Vs. Dr. Ruchi Baid" is directed to be transferred from the Family Court, Jodhpur to the Family Court, Jaipur.

The parties shall remain present before the Family Court, Jaipur on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2017. The Family Court, Jaipur is directed to take every step for expeditious disposal of the matter and to dispose off the case preferably within a period of one year from 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2017.

The transfer petition stands disposed off accordingly.
